RESULTS AND CONCLUSIONS

On September 24, 2010, the Louisiana State Police Crime Laboratory was requested by Captain B [redacted] T [redacted] of the Baton Rouge Police Department to assist in a homicide/attempted homicide investigation involving the death of a 42-year-old white female and the shooting of a 9-year-old white female in East Baton Rouge Parish. The crime scene was located at [redacted] Beauregard Street in Baton Rouge, Louisiana.

The Louisiana State Police Crime Laboratory assisted in collection and documentation of shoe impression evidence at the scene.

Numerous areas of suspected blood were observed on the front porch and throughout the residence. Crime Lab personnel were requested to search for and enhance any possible areas where suspected bloody shoe impressions could be found.

A partial shoe impression in dirt was observed on one of the steps leading to the back porch of the residence.



Photographs of the impression (Exhibit 14) were taken and forwarded for Impression Comparison analysis.

The hallway floor near the threshold between the kitchen and hallway, the kitchen counter to the left of the sink, the kitchen floor in front of the sink, the kitchen floor in front of the washer/dryer, and the kitchen floor near the threshold between the kitchen and hallway were processed with amido black. After processing, a shoe impression was observed on the kitchen floor near the threshold between the kitchen and hallway. This impression is most consistent with traveling in the direction from the hallway into the kitchen. Photographs of the impression (Exhibit 15) were taken and the area of flooring (Exhibit 40) containing the shoe impression was removed. These items were forwarded for Impression Comparison analysis.

Photographs were taken at the crime scene and copies of these can be made available upon request.
